Amendment to Bombay Civil Services Rule 753 and Rule 6 of the Revised Leave Rule, 1935.

# Resolution No. LVE. 2468/13/68-X.

### Sachivalaya, Bombay-32, dated the 11th October 1968.

Under the provisions of note 6(i) and (ii) below Bombay Civil Services Rule 161, a Government servant may be required to retire or may himself choose to retire after attaining the age of 55 years by giving notice of not less than three months. Under paragraph 5 of Government Circular, Finance Department, No. 1463/39 G. of I./63-X, dated the 16th April 1963, such a Government servant may be allowed leave due and admissible, not extending beyond the date on which he attains the age of 58 years, even though it extends beyond the expiry of the notice period. On the basis of this provision, Government is pleased to make amendments to Bombay Civil services Rule 753 and Rule 6 of the Revised Leave Rules, 1935 as per the Notification enclosed. The usual requirement of application for leave before the expiry of the notice will of course have to be followed in all such cases, as in the absence of application, all leave lapses on the date of retirement, which is the date of expiry of the notice.
