Misappropriation of Village Panchayat Funds.

GOVERNMENT OF MAHARASHTRA. Rural Development Department. Resolution No. VPF-1570/21116-E. Sachivalaya, Bombay-32(BR), Dated the 14th December 1971.

READ:- Government Resolution, Rural Development Department No. VPF-1570/21116-E, dated the 3rd November 1970.

<u>RESOLUTION</u>:- In para 4(a)(ii) of Government Resolution, Rural Development Department, No.VPF-1570/21116-E, dated the 3rd November 1970 it has been observed that it is necessary to prescribe some time-limit within which investigations should be completed by the police. A time-limit of three months has accordingly been prescribed in that para. Government has re-examined the question in regard to the time-limit prescribed and is accordingly pleased to substitute the aforesaid para as follows :-

"It is necessary to have some time-limit within which investigations should be completed by the police. The following time-limits for completing investigations by police are prescribed :---

 In cases which are simple and where on the available data and evidence, without Audit Report or the Opinion of the Handwriting Experts, conviction can be obtained, the time-limit may be three months:

(2) In cases where the opinion of the Handwriting Expert in alone is necessary, the time-limit may be six months;

and

DEc 197 months of the receipt of the Audit Report."

2. One of the reasons for delay in investigation by the police is that information and record required by them is not furnished to them by the Zilla Parishad authorities without any delay. The Chief Executive Officers of Zilla Parishads and the Block Development Officers are requested to see that full c-operation in this regard is given by all concerned to the



police authorities and whatever information and record is required by the police is immediately furnished to them.
