RESOLUTION OF GOVERNMENT.

Under rule 8 of Appendix I of the Bombay Civil Service Rules, Volume II, the rate of study allowance to be granted to Government Servants, who take study leave in countries other than the United Kingdom, the continent of Europe and the United States of America, is specifically considered by the Government in each case.

2/- Government is now pleased to direct that the rate of study allowance for a Government servant, who takes study leave in India is half the rate of the full daily allowance to which he is entitled under rules regulating his travelling allowance if he were on tour to the place of study.

3/- When a Government servant is on leave at the same place as his place of duty leave salary plus the study allowance together should not exceed the pay he would have drawn otherwise.
