RESOLUTION OF GOVERNMENT.

In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to article 309 of the constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to direct that the following amendment shall be made in the Bombay Civil Service Rules, Volume I, First Edition, 1959.
Page 266 Rule 774

Substitute the following for the existing rules:-

"774. A competent authority may grant hospital leave to a Class IV Government Servant and such Class III Government Servants whose duties involve handling of dangerous machinery, explosive materials, poisonous drugs etc. or the performance of hazardous tasks, while under medical treatment for illness or injury if such illness or injury is directly due to risks incurred in the course of their official duties. Such leave should be granted on production by the Government servant concerned of a medical certificate from his authorised Medical Attendant to the effect that the illness or injury was directly due to risks incurred in the course of official duties and also that leave recommended is necessary to effect a cure."
