Simplification of the method of calculation of leave salary - Leave salary while on earned leave equal to the last pay drawn.

RESOLUTION:

According to Rule 14 of the Revised Leave Rules, 1935 (substituted under Government notification, Finance Department No.LVE-1064/2476/64/X, dated 28th April 1965, Correction slip No.286 to Revised Leave Rules, 1935 Appendix XL IV4, Bombay Civil Services Rules, Volume II read with Government Notification, Finance Department No.LVE 1068/62-68-X, dated 5th October 1968), a Government servant who proceeds on earned leave from a post the maximum of which exceeds Rs.300/- is entitled to leave salary equal to the average monthly pay earned during the ten complete months immediately preceding the month in which the leave commences (i.e. excluding the month/months he was partly on leave and partly on duty) or the substantive pay to which the Government servant is entitled immediately before the commencement of the leave, whichever is greater. Calculation of leave salary on the basis of average monthly pay is not, however, necessary in the case of those holding posts, the maximum of the scale of pay of which does not exceed Rs.300 p.m.

2. As a measure of simplification of accounting procedure Govt. is pleased to direct that Rule 14(1) of the Revised Leave Rules, 1935 should be amended to provide that all Government servants should be entitled to leave salary equal to the pay drawn immediately before proceeding on earned leave.

3. These orders shall apply to Government servants who proceed on leave on or after 1st August, 1976.
