R E S O L U T I O N

The block period for encashment of earned leave admissible under Government Resolution, Finance Department, No. LVE 2470/634/70-X, dated the 15th May 1970 will expire on 31st March, 1972. It has been represented to Government that due to scarcity relief work and forthcoming General Elections to State Legislature, it will not be possible to sanction leave to a large number of Government servants and thereby they will be deprived of the benefit of encashment of leave during the remaining period of the current block of two years ending on 31st March 1972. Government has decided that in respect of Government servants who could not avail of the encashment of leave during the block period 1970-72 should be allowed to avail of the same till 31st March, 1973. The period of the next block will however, remain intact and will continue to commence from 1st April 1972.

In case a Government servant applies for encashment of leave both for the first block as well as for the second block any time before 31st March 1973 simultaneously a question would arise whether the benefit for both the blocks should be allowed simultaneously. It is hereby clarified that in such cases, subject to other conditions of the Government Resolution, Finance Department, dated the 15th May 1970 being satisfied, and, subject to the exigencies of public service, there may be no objection to allow such Government servants to avail of the benefit for both the blocks simultaneously.
