Resolution - A number of cases have been reported to Government, in which the Government servants, who have been allowed to avail of the benefit of surrendered leave, but expired during the pendency of the first 30 days of earned leave, for regularising the payment of leave salary for the surrendered leave already made. The question whether the leave salary paid should be recovered in such cases was under consideration of Government. Government is now pleased to direct that payment of leave salary for the surrendered leave already made, (including that authorised to a Government servant and collected in the meantime by his legal heirs) should be treated as valid payment made in relaxation of Government Resolution, Finance Department No. LVE-2470/634/70-X, dated the 15th May 1970.

2. Government is also pleased to direct that in the case of a Government servant who has proceeded on 30 days earned leave with the benefit of surrendered leave, but who expires before leave salary for the surrendered leave is paid, family or legal heirs of the deceased Government servant, should be paid in relaxation of the orders contained in Government Resolution, Finance Department, dated 15th May 1970 referred to above, the full leave salary for the leave already surrendered.
