In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to direct that the following amendment shall be made to the Bombay Civil Services Rules, Volume I, First Edition, 1959 :-

Page 66. Rule 161(d)

In Note 1, under clause (a) of this rule, as <u>substituted</u> under Government Resolution, Finance Department No.RBS 1260-4251-X. dated the 11th January 1961 for the words " and the Gov-Government Servant shall not be permitted to vetain a lien on his permanent post or any other post during the period of such leave " the words " for the purposes of pensionary or Contributory Provident Fund benefits or the retention of lien. The Government Servant shall retire and become eligible for all pensionary benefits as due the to him on the date of compulsory retirement, or such other later date if any extension of service is granted, from the date of expiry of such leave " shall be substituted.
