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Transfer of General Provident Fund

RESOLUTION :- A large number of Class III and Class IV Government servants borne on partially surplus cadres (vide Section 253-B of the Maharashtra Zilla Parishads and Panchayat Samitis Act, 1961) and wholly surplus cadres (vide section 242 of the Act) have been finally allotted to Zilla Parishads respectively under sections 253 C and 242 of the Act. The dates on which they have been finally allotted are specified below for ready reference

(A) 1st March 1971 (vide action taken in pursuance of Government Resolution, Rural Development Department No. ALT 1070/37117-S, dated 25th August 1970 to allot Government servants under section 253 C of the Act).

1st September 1971 (vide action taken in pursuance of Government Resolution, Rural Development Department No. ALT 1070/21509-S, dated 17.6.1971 to allot Government servants under section 253 C of the Act).

(B) 1st March 1973 (vide action taken in pursuance of Government Resolutions, Rural Development Department and  
1st November 1973 No. ALT 1072/853(III)-S, dated 27th March 1972, No. CDP 1072/30502-AII, dated 7.12.1972, No. ALT 1073/2020-S, dated 27.2.73 and No. ALT-1073/35425-S, dated 1.11.73 to allot Government servants under Section 242 of the Act).

2. Until allotment and absorption of these employees in the District Services, the General Provident Fund Accounts of Class III personnel amongst them have had to be maintained by the Accountant General, Maharashtra, Bombay/Magpur and those of Class IV personnel by the respective Heads of Departments of Government even while many of these allotted employees may have been on deputation to Zilla Parishads before their allotment to Zilla Parishads. From the date of allotment it is the responsibility of the Chief Executive Officers of Zilla Parishads to make the necessary arrangements to open accounts of the individuals in accordance with the provisions of rule 229 of the Maharashtra Zilla Parishads and Panchayat Samitis Account Code, 1968 and other orders in that behalf and it is necessary that the Accountant General concerned and the Heads of Departments of Government are requested to transfer the accounts of the individuals to the respective Zilla Parishads.

3. It has been brought to the notice of Government that most of the Chief Executive Officers have not opened the individual General Provident Fund Accounts of the allotted Government servants. It was decided by Government in consultation with the Accountant General, Bombay to close the accounts of the allotted Class III Government servants with effect from April 1973 and for this purpose names of such allotted Class III Government servants were called for from the Chief Executive Officers of Zilla parishads by Government letter, Rural Development Department No. PFR 1073/9087-AIII, dated the 26th March 1973. Most of the Chief Executive Officers have not supplied the information and those that have supplied it have each sent lists of not more than about 15-20 persons. Evidently the Chief Executive Officers and Chief Accounts and Finance Officers have not paid attention to this important matter.

4. Government has now decided that classification of the General Provident Fund recoveries/withdrawals in respect of the Government servants finally allotted to Zilla Parishads, under "G.P.F. other than Class IV or "GPF class IV" as the case may be, should be stopped with effect from 1st April 1976 and the Chief Executive Officer of Zilla Parishad should arrange to open new Provident Fund accounts of these persons at his end for maintaining these Accounts with effect from 1st April 1976. Every Chief Executive Officer of Zilla Parishad should forward to the Accountant General, Maharashtra, Bombay/Nagpur latest by the 30th April 1976 lists (in the attached form of Class III and Class IV Government servants already finally allotted to the Zilla Parishad whose General Provident Fund accounts should be closed by the Accountant General. The list should be complete and should specify against each employee's name (i) the old General Provident Fund account No. as recorded in the Accountant General's records/record or the Head of Government Department and (ii) the new General Provident Fund account No. allotted by the Zilla Parishad. There should be separate lists for each Provident Fund series (viz. GA/MAH, AG/MAH etc.). Lists in respect of Class IV employees should be separate and Department-wise and copies thereof should be sent simultaneously to the respective Government Heads of Departments concerned. The Accountant General will thereupon transfer, after 1st May 1976 to the new No. under the Zilla Parishad the account of the General Provident Fund balance with interest to the credit of the employee as it will stand on the 1st May 1976.

5. The Chief Executive Officers of Zilla Parishads should send Rural Development Department latest by 15th May 1976 their compliance report with reference to para 4 above. No difficulties or bottlenecks should be allowed to hinder the timely compliance of the instruction and the Chief Executive Officers should be personally and fully responsible for the whole task.
