## RESOLUTION OF GOVERNMENT

According to Rule 5 of the Leave Travel Concession Rules contained in Schedule accompanying Government Resolution, Finance Department, No.TRA-1163/2726-V, dated 23rd October 1963, the last date for making declaration of 'home-town' by the Government servants who were in service on 1st October 1963, was the <u>31st March 1964</u>. It has been represented to Government that the time allowed for making the declaration has proved inadequate in certain cases. After careful consideration, Government has decided that the last date for making the declaration should be extended by six months more, <u>1.e.</u> upto the <u>30th</u> September 1964. All Heads of Departments are requested to bring these orders immediately to the notice of the Government servants who have not so far made this declaration. It should be made clear to all concerned that no further extension will be allowed.
