RESOLUTION OF GOVERNMENT.

Paragraph 21 of the accompaniment to the Government Resolution, Finance Department, No.TRA-1163/2726-V dated the 23rd October 1963 lays down inter alia that the advance in respect of Government servants and their families will be sanctioned subject to the production by them of surety of a permanent Government servant. Government is pleased to **direct** that the surety from a permanent Government servant should be obtained in the *accompanying form or any other form of Security considered adequate by the sanctioning authority.

2. The authorities competent to sanction these advances may, at their discretion, dispense with this requirement in the case of temporary staff who have completed 3 years of continuous service and are likely to continue in service till the adjustment of the advance.

FORM OF SURETY BOND.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT I _____

made I hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and
representatives firmly by these presents. In witness whereof I set

Whereas _____ son of _____ a resident

present employed as temporary _____ in the

(hereinafter called "The Borrower") has, at his own request, been
granted by the Government an advance of Rs. _____ (Rupees
_____ only) on account of leave travel
concessions.

AND WHEREAS THE Borrower has undertaken to prefer his/her
travelling allowance claim in adjustment of the amount of advance
of Rs. _____ (Rupees _____) as
required by the provisions of schedule to Government Resolution,
Finance Department, No.TRA.1163/2726/V, dated 23rd October, 1963 and
to refund to the Government such sum as he/she may have drawn in
excess of the claim as passed.

AND WHEREAS the Surety has agreed to execute the above bond with
such condition as is hereunder written.

NOW THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION is such that if the said
Borrower shall utilise the said advance for the purposes of the
said journey which he/she shall commence within a period of fifteen
days of the grant of such advance and further shall within a period
of one month from the date of the completion of his/her return
journey prefer or cause to be preferred his/her travelling allowance
claim in adjustment of the said amount of advance of Rs. _____
drawn by him/her and to refund to the Government such sum as he/she
may have drawn in excess of claim as passed forthwith thereafter
then this bond shall be void, otherwise the same shall be and remain

in full force and virtue. BUT SO NEVERTHELESS that if the Borrower shall die or become insolvent or at any time cease to be in the service of the Government, the whole or so much of the said sum of Rs. _____ (Rupees _____ only) as shall then be refundable by the Borrower to the Government according to the said Government Resolution shall immediately become due and payable to the Government and be recoverable from the Surety as arrears of land revenue in one instalment by virtue of this bond.

The obligation undertaken by the Surety shall not be discharged or in any way affected by an extension of time or any other indulgence granted by the Government to the said Borrower.

The Government shall bear the stamp duty, in respect of these presents.
