CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. CDR. 1185/2777/3/XI.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules, 1979, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline and Appeal) (Amendment) Rules, 1986.

2. In rule 6 of the Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules, 1979, after the second proviso to sub-rule (2), the following proviso shall be added, namely :—

“Provided also that, the Heads of Departments shall exercise the powers of imposing minor penalties only in relation to Government servants of State service (Class-I) under their respective administrative control who draw pay in a scale, the minimum of which does not exceed Rs. 1,000”.
