## RESOLUTION OF GOVERNMENT.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 309 of the Constitution of India and in modification of Government Resolution, Finance Department, No. DRS. 1055, dated 20th October 1955, Government is pleased to direct that the following amendment shall be made in the Bombay Civil Services Rules Manual, 2rd Edition (2nd reprint), Volume 1:-

1. Page 55, Rule 151-

Delete the amendment made in item 1 of Government Resolution, Finance Department, No. DRS. 1055, dated 20th October 1955 and substitute the following for the first three provisos to clause (b) of this rule :--

" In addition he may be granted to such extent and subject to such conditions as the authority ordering his suspension may direct :

(i) Dearness allowance not exceeding the amount admissible as such had he been on leave on leave salary equal to the rate of subsistence allowance payable from time to time and;

(ii) Any other compensatory allowance of which he was in receipt on the date of suspension;

(iii) The compensatory Local ellowance and house rent allowance will not be drawn after the first four months of suspension."
