
Please refer to your office letter number SBHI & VS/D-83/IT/amendment 2008/ PCMC Corpn./31879 dated 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2012 vide which permission of electronic signature on birth death certificates has been sought. In this connection, it is clarified that the provisions of I.T. Act, 2000 and amendments made thereunder from time to time take care the legal validity and recognition of electronic records and electronic signatures.

2. Hence, under the provisions of IT Act 2000 and corresponding amendments made thereunder, electronic signature can be used for issuance of birth/death certificate. However while doing so, it should be ensured that there is no violation of Section 7(2) of the RBD Act, 1969, which specifies the Jurisdiction of each Registrar / Sub Registrar.
