CIRCULAR OF GOVERNMENT

Government has prescribed reservation for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Castes converts to Buddhism, Scheduled Tribes including those living outside the specified areas, Denotified and Nomadic Tribes at the stage of promotion- vide, Government Resolution, General Administration Department, No.BCC-1072/J, dated the 23rd May 1974. It was directed in Government Circular, General Administration Department, No.BCC-1072-J, dated the 21.1.1975 that the orders issued in Government Resolution, dated the 23rd May 1974 which were stayed for a brief period from the 1.1.1975 to the 21.1.1975 owing to the ad-interim stay given by the High Court, should be implemented, except in the case of promotion of Aval Karkuns to the posts of Naib Tahsildars in the Revenue Department in the Aurangabad Division.

2. It has, however, come to the notice of Government that these orders are not being implemented strictly by the Secretariat Departments and the Heads of the Departments in as much as :-

(1) Departmental Promotion Committees have not yet been set up by some Departments/Offices.

(2) Vacancies which have occurred after the 23.5.1974 have not been filled in accordance with the instructions issued in Government Resolution, dated the 23rd May 1974 by some Departments,

(3) Temporary vacancies exceeding three months have not been taken into account by some Departments for the purposes of reservation for the three sections of the Backward Classes. (Govt.Circular, G.A.D., No.BCC-1072/J, dated the 6.9.1974),

(4) Promotions which were effected during the brief period of ad-interim stay given by the High Court i.e. from the 1.1.1975 to the 21.1.1975 in accordance with the orders in force before the issuance of Government Resolution on the 23.5.74 have not been regularised as directed in Government Resolution, G.A.D., No.BCC-1072/J, dated the 21st January 1975.

3. All Departments of the Secretariat and Heads of Departments are, therefore, requested to ensure that :-

(1) Departmental Promotion Committees are set up immediately, if they have not already been set up.

(2) Vacancies which have occurred after the 23.5.1974 are filled strictly in accordance with the instructions contained in Government Resolution, G.A.D., No. BCC-1072/J, dated the 23rd May, 1974.

(3) Temporary vacancies exceeding three months are taken into account for the purposes of reservation for the three sections of the Backward Classes as directed in Government Circular, G.A.D., No. BCC-1072/J, dated the 6th September, 1974, and

(4) If any promotions, other than those of Awal Karkuns to posts of Naib Tahsildars in the Revenue Department in Aurangabad Division have been effected during the brief period of ad-interim stay given by the High Court i.e. from 1.1.1975 to 21.1.1975, they should be regularised as directed in Government Circular, G.A.D., No. BCC-1072/J, dated the 21st January 1975.

4. The Heads of Departments should also ensure that these orders are implemented scrupulously by the Heads of Offices under their administrative control.
