CIRCULAR OF GOVERNMENT

In Government Circular, General Administration Department, No. BCC 1070(ECR-5)-J, dated the 8th May 1970, it was directed that the recognised voluntary agencies receiving Government grants should be required to employ the same percentage of Backward Class candidates as prescribed for Government service, on their staff at all levels, if the total strength of the employees of the institution concerned exceeds 10, and that a suitable clause regarding reservation in service for Backward Class candidates should be included in the grant-in-aid rules applicable to recognised voluntary agencies receiving grant-in-aid from Government. It has now been decided that for entitlement of grant-in-aid, the institutions concerned should be given one year's time to comply with Government policy and orders regarding reservation of vacancies for Backward Classes.

All Departments of the Secretariat are, therefore, requested to take suitable action for implementing the above-mentioned orders in respect of voluntary agencies to whom grant-in-aid is given by them or by the Heads of Departments/Offices under their administrative control.
