- READ:- (1) Government Resolution, General Administration Department, No. BCC/1064/III/J, dated the 9th April 1965.
- (2) Government Resolution, General Administration Department, No. BCC/1070/ECR/J, dated the 9th March 1971.

RESOLUTION:- By Government Resolution, General Administration Department, No. BCC/1064/III/J, dated the 9th April 1965, the percentage of vacancies occurring in each of the various services under Government which are filled by direct recruitment is reserved for members of each of the Sections as follows:-

(a) Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Castes converts to Buddhism.	13%
(b) Scheduled Tribes including those living outside the specified areas.	7%
(c) Denotified Tribes and Nomadic Tribes.	4%
(d) Other Backward Communities.	10%

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2. The Backward Class Employment Committee had recommended that recruitment to 66% general posts, which is on merit, should include Backward Class candidates selected on merit, and that in addition 34% should be reserved for Backward Class candidates subject to the proviso that the number of Backward Class candidates selected on merit, and those appointed against reserved quota of 34% should not exceed 50%.

3. Government has carefully considered the recommendation of the Backward Class Employment Committee, and is pleased to direct that in order to make up the consistent shortfall in filling up reserved vacancies, henceforth recruitment to 66% general posts, which is on merit, should include Backward Class candidates, selected on merit, and that in addition, 34% vacancies as specified in paragraph 1 should be reserved for Backward Class candidates subject to the proviso that the number of Backward Class candidates selected on merit and those appointed against reserved quota of 34% should not exceed 40% of the total vacancies to be filled up on any occasion of recruitment. The orders regarding carrying forward of reserved vacancies issued in Government Resolution, General Administration Department, No. BCC-1070/(ECR)-J, dated the 28th May 1971 should continue to remain in force.

These orders should take effect from the date of issue, and be applicable throughout the State, and should remain in force for a period of three years.

4. Government is also pleased to direct that orders issued in Government Resolution, General Administration Department, No.BCC-1070/ECR/J, dated the 9th March 1971, should be treated as cancelled, and henceforth vacancies reserved for the particular sections of the Backward Classes should be filled in by appointing candidates of only those sections of the Backward Classes for whom they have been reserved. If the vacancies cannot be filled, vacancies for the particular section of the Backward Class should be carried forward till they are filled by members of that section upto a period of five years.

5. All appointing authorities should take particular care to see that these orders are followed scrupulously.
