CIRCULAR OF GOVERNMENT.

It has been brought to the notice of Government that recruiting authorities insist upon knowledge of typewriting even in respect of clerical posts for which typewriting is not prescribed as a basic qualification and on that ground, reject candidates belonging to the Backward Class recommended to them by the Director of Backward Class Welfare. This is not correct. It has been the accepted policy of Government to adopt all possible measures for the uplift of the Backward Classes and in pursuance of that policy Government has reserved certain percentages of vacancies occurring in the various services under it in favour of them vide Government Resolution, Political and Services Department, No. 490/46, dated the 24th January 1953. The intention is that the Backward Class candidates possessing the minimum prescribed qualifications should be considered for appointment in the vacancies reserved for them. Government is therefore pleased to direct that qualifications which are not prescribed as essential should not be insisted upon in their case. Government is also pleased to direct that whenever clerical vacancies are reported by the recruiting authorities to the Director of Backward Class Welfare it should be clearly indicated to him whether typewriting is an essential qualification and whether the posts for which candidates are required are merely clerical posts or posts of clerk-typists, typists or stenographers.
