CIRCULAR OF GOVERNMENT

Recruitment to several Class III and Class IV posts is made by selection on the basis of interviews. It is possible that when the candidates belonging to Backward Classes are interviewed for vacancies reserved for them along with other non-Backward Class candidates, they may not be judged properly for selection with due regard to the need for relaxation of standards in their favour. It has, therefore, been decided that for reserved vacancies, interviews of Backward Class candidates should be held on a day or sitting of the Selection Committee/Board other than the day or sitting on which general candidates are to be interviewed so that the Backward Class candidates are not judged in comparison with general candidates, and the interviewing authority/Selection Committee is prominently aware of the need for ~~BOARD~~ judging the Backward Class candidates by relaxed standards.

All Departments of the Secretariat and the Heads of Departments are requested to bring these orders to the notice of the concerned authorities under their administrative control.
