Circular of Government.

Whenever a person who is drawing pay in a time-scale containing an efficiency bar is due to cross the bar, the question whether or not he should be permitted to cross the bar is generally considered within a reasonable period from the date on which he becomes due to cross the bar. Some times, however, for one reason or the other, consideration of the question is delayed and the question then arises whether in determining the suitability of the person concerned for being allowed to cross the bar his record only upto the date on which he was due to cross the bar should be taken into account, or whether it is open to the competent authority to take into account his subsequent record also. Government has decided that in such cases though the suitability of the person for crossing the efficiency bar may be primarily based on his record up to the date on which he is due to cross the bar, the competent authority is not precluded from taking into account his subsequent record also upto the date when he takes up the question of allowing the person concerned to cross the bar and he, i.e. the competent authority should, therefore, take such record also into account and decide the suitability of the person to cross the bar on the basis of his entire record up to the date of the consideration of the question.

2. All Departments and Officers are requested to follow the foregoing instructions whenever they have to determine the suitability of a person to cross the efficiency bar.
