

Matters relating to the welfare of
Backward Class candidates in
various services -
Instructions in respect of --

READ:- Government Circular, General Administration Department,
No. SRV-1075/X, dated the 24th July, 1975.

CIRCULAR :- According to the Government Circular, General Administration Department, No. SRV-1075/X, dated the 24th July, 1975, cases containing requisitions for advertising to Class I and Class II posts are not required to be shown to the General Administration Department, if there is no deviation from the general orders regarding reservation of vacancies. It has, however, been observed that reservation for Backward Classes is not correctly shown in the requisitions sent by some of the Mantralaya Departments to the Maharashtra Public Service Commission for advertising to Class I and Class II posts in various services. In order to avoid submission of any erroneous requisitions to the Maharashtra Public Service Commission, all the Departments of the Mantralaya are requested, in modification of the orders referred to above, to show all papers regarding requisitions invariably to the General Administration Department (Backward Class Cell) for prior scrutiny, before they are sent to the Maharashtra Public Service Commission. They are also requested to indicate in the forwarding letter to the Commission that the requisition has been scrutinised by the General Administration Department (Backward Class Cell).

2. According to Government Resolution, General Administration Department, No. SRV-1074/D, dated the 28th January, 1975, an officer belonging to one of the Backward Classes, if available is required to be nominated on each of the Departmental Promotion Committee. It has been observed that though an officer belonging to one of the Backward Classes is available in some of the Departments, has not been appointed on the Departmental Promotion Committee. All the Departments of the Mantralaya are, therefore, requested to ensure that an officer belonging to Backward Class, if available is nominated on the Departmental Promotion Committee.
