C I R C U L A R

It has come to the notice of Government that sometimes the claims of Backward Class candidates for promotion are set aside on the ground of unsatisfactory confidential reports without having regard to the orders contained in Government Resolution, General Administration Department No. BAC-1057-J, dated the 7th January 1961, which require that the cases of Government servants belonging to the Backward Classes should be judged with special sympathy and promotion should not be denied to such Government servants unless they are considered definitely unfit for promotion or unless promotion is ordered by competent authority to be withheld as a measure of punishment. Attention is invited to Government Circular, General Administration Department No. BCC-1068-J, dated the 18th September 1969 in which the Deputy Secretaries in charge of establishment in the Secretariat Departments who are Liaison Officers in connection with the recruitment of Backward Classes were asked to ensure that the returns relating to the cases of supersession of Backward Class Government servants are ~~are~~ scrutinised in their respective Departments in the light of Government policy in the matter. In order to enable Government to examine this question, it is considered necessary to ascertain the magnitude of the problem regarding supersession of Backward Class Government servants in Class III service. All Departments of the Secretariat are, therefore, requested to furnish information in respect of the cases of supersession of Government servants belonging to the Backward Classes in Class III service on the ground of unsatisfactory confidential record during the last 10 years i.e. since the issue of the orders in Government Resolution dated the 7th January 1961. The information should be sent to the General Administration Department in the proforma appended by 15th March 1971 at the latest and should include information for the Secretariat Department proper as well as all Heads of Departments and Offices under its administrative control.
