of Backward Classes in

carrying forward of
reserved vacancies.

R E S O L U T I O N

In Government Resolution, General Administration Department, No.BCC-1064-III-J, dated the 9th April 1965, it was directed that the vacancies reserved for Backward Classes which are not filled in by candidates belonging to Backward Classes in a particular year should be carried forward for not more than 2 years and that the total number of normal reserved vacancies and the carried forward vacancies together should not exceed 45 per cent of the total number of vacancies on any occasion of recruitment.

Government has recently considered various measures with a view to removing the backlog in the percentages of Backward Classes in Government service, and has decided that the present provision for carrying forward of reserved vacancies for 2 years only should be liberalised with a view to ensuring that the vacancies reserved for Backward Classes are filled in according to the prescribed percentages. Government is, therefore, pleased to direct in modification of the orders issued in Government Resolution, General Administration Department, No.BCC-1064-III-J, dated the 9th April 1965, that the reserved vacancies which are not filled in by the appointment of members of Backward Classes in a particular year should be carried forward for 5 years instead of 2 years subject to the proviso that the reserved vacancies and the carried forward vacancies together should not exceed 50 per cent. of the total vacancies on any occasion of recruitment.

All appointing authorities should see that these orders are following scrupulously and that the vacancies reserved for Backward Classes are filled in accordance with the prescribed percentages.
