C I R C U L A R

Orders have been issued providing for reservation of vacancies occurring in the different services filled by direct recruitment for members of the various sections of the Backward Class - vide Government Resolution, General Administration Department No. BCC-1064-III-J, dated the 9th April 1965. The vacancies however in most of the cases occur in small numbers and at varying intervals. Unless therefore, a definite procedure is laid down for determining the number of vacancies to be reserved for the different sections of the Backward Class, the recruiting authorities may not be able to reserve vacancies for the different sections in terms of the reservation orders. Government is, therefore, pleased to lay down the following procedure in this respect:-

Each appointing authority should maintain a register in the appended proforma for each category of posts for which direct recruitment is made. One hundred or a smaller suitable number to be fixed in consultation with the administrative department having regard to the size of the cadre and the frequency with which vacancies to be filled in by direct recruitment occur, should be decided as a unit for this purpose. The register should show how each vacancy should be filled in terms of the reservation orders. Thus when the unit is of 100 vacancies, every 8th vacancy should be reserved for a member of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Castes converts to Buddhism, every 14th for those of Scheduled Tribes including those living outside the specified areas, every 25th for those of Denotified and Nomadic Tribes and every 10th for those of other Backward Communities. The appointing authorities should then ensure that the vacancies are filled according to the reservation indicated in this register and that if on any occasion the vacancies reserved for a particular section of the Backward Class are not filled in by candidates of that particular section, the necessary note is taken so that the vacancies can be taken into account and made available to members of that particular section on subsequent occasions. They should also ensure that unfilled vacancies are not carried forward in this manner for more than two years as provided for by the General Orders by a periodical check of the register.
