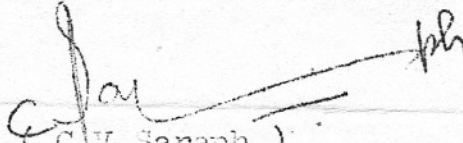

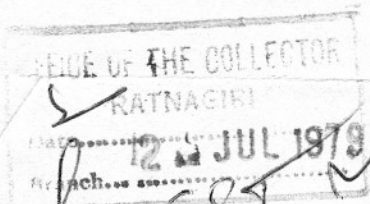
C I R C U L A R

It has come to the notice of Government that in a large number of cases of temporary Government servants who are considered eligible for grant of permanency certificate according to the orders issued in Government Resolution, General Administration Department No. SRV-1075-X, dated the 19th September 1975 such certificates have not yet been issued by the concerned Appointing Authorities. It is needless to emphasise that delay in issuing permanency certificates in respect of eligible Government servants causes undue hardships to them and also puts them in disadvantageous position.

2. All Heads of Departments and Offices are, therefore, requested to examine the cases of all temporary Government servants who are considered eligible for grant of permanency certificates immediately and to ensure that necessary certificates are issued to them by the 31st August 1979, at the latest, if not already issued.
