RESOLUTION

Under Government Resolution, General Administration
Department No. SRV-1075-X, dated the 19th September 1975, orders
have been issued that every Government servant who has rendered
continuous service for not less than 3 years in a post or posts
(excluding those on the converted Regular Temporary establishment)
included in a cadre and who satisfies the conditions mentioned
in the said Government Resolution should be deemed to be a
permanent Government servant for all purposes, including the
admissibility of full pensionary benefits. It has since been
noticed that Government servants allocated from the former
Madhya Pradesh and Hyderabad States who were not confirmed in
any post in the former States and who have been absorbed in a
cadre higher than the one to which they were initially recruited
in the former States do not become eligible for the benefits of
substantive status in Government service under the orders
referred to above, and they may have to retire without being
confirmed. With a view to obviating such a possibility Govern-
ment is pleased to direct that such of the Government servants
allocated from the former Madhya Pradesh and Hyderabad States
who were not confirmed in any post in the former States and
who have been absorbed on 1st November 1956 in a cadre higher
than the one to which they were initially recruited in the for-
mer States should also be held eligible for the benefits of
permanency under the Government Resolution, General Administra-
tion Department No. SRV-1075-X, dated the 19th September, 1975
with reference to the cadre with which the cadre of their initial
recruitment is equated in the reorganised Bombay State subject
to the other conditions stipulated for the grant of permanency
benefits ~~will also apply~~.
