R E S O L U T I O N .

In paragraph 4.28 of its report the Administrative Reorganisation Committee has stressed the necessity of weeding out an unsuitable officer when he is on probation if the administration is not to be burdened with misfits and with material of doubtful value.

2. Government has accepted the recommendation and is pleased to direct that the probationary period should not be extended from time to time. Further with a view to laying down a uniform limit in respect of extension of probationary period, it is directed that the probationary period should not be extended by a period of more than one year and after this limit is reached, either the probationary period should be terminated or the services of the probationer should be dispensed with.
