From Class IV services to Class III Services
Clarification regarding.

Circular

In accordance with the orders mentioned in the preamble the
Class IV employees, who have passed S.S.C. Examination equivalent
examination, while in service and who have rendered continuous
service of three years, are to be eligible for promotion to Class III
(i.e. clerical cadre), provided they are considered suitable for
such promotion.

2. A point has been raised as to whether a Class IV employee on
getting through the S.S.C. Examination or an equivalent examination
may be placed at the bottom on the waiting list of candidates for
the post of Clerk or he may be appointed in an immediate available
vacancy in Class III service and whether he may be deputed to the
pre-recruitment training and if so, how his remuneration for the
training period may be regularised.

3. Government has carefully considered these questions and is
pleased to direct that a Class IV employee satisfying the prescribed
conditions indicated above and who is considered suitable for promo-
-tion should be promoted in an immediate available vacancy in Class
III service and he should be deputed for the prescribed training
as an in service candidate and should be paid pay and allowances as
Class III employee in relaxation of the orders contained in Govt.
Resolution, Revenue and Forests Department No. TRN 1075/100702-T,
dated 29th September 1973.

It is not necessary to bring the name of any such Class IV
eligible employee, in the Select List of Candidates for appointment
as a Clerk.
