

Promotion - from Class IV services to Class III services in Government offices and departments.

RESOLUTION

According to the orders contained in Government Circular No. RTR-1164/J, dated the 16th October 1964, only a member of class IV service, who passes the S.S.C. Examination while in service is eligible for promotion to a post of clerk, if he has completed 3 years continuous service in class IV service. Government had under consideration for some time past the question of revising these orders so as to make them applicable even to those members of class IV service, who join this service after passing the S.S.C. Examination.

2. Government is now pleased to direct as follows :-

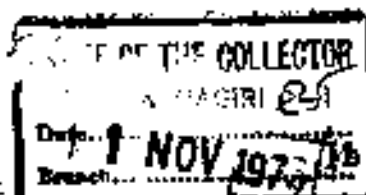
(1) The present orders according to which only those, who pass the S.S.C. Examination after joining service in class IV, are held eligible for promotion to clerical posts after completing 3 years service in class IV, should be liberalised so as to make even those, who had already passed the S.S.C. Examination at the time of their joining class IV service, eligible for promotion to clerical posts, subject to the same condition, viz., that they should have put in atleast three years service in class IV service.

(2) The number of vacancies in the clerical cadre to be filled in by the promotion of class IV persons falling in both the categories viz., (i) those, who had already passed the S.S.C. Examination at the time of their appointment to class IV, and (ii) those, who pass that examination after their appointment to class IV, should not exceed 10% of the vacancies occurring in a particular year.

(3) The seniority of those, who had already passed the S.S.C. Examination at the time of joining class IV service vis-a-vis those, who pass that examination after joining that service for the purpose of promotion to class III posts/services should be determined as follows :-

(a) In the case of those, who had already passed the S.S.C. Examination at the time of joining the Class IV service, for the purpose of seniority, their appointment should be deemed to be from a date three years after the date of their joining the service;

In the case of those, who pass the S.S.C. Examination after joining the class IV service, their date of appointment for the purpose of seniority, should be deemed to be from the date on which they complete three years' service or pass the S.S.C. Examination, whichever is later.



3. The other conditions prescribed for regulating the promotion of the class IV personnel to clerical posts by the previous orders will, however, continue to apply. Recruitment rules for Class III posts/services should be amended suitably.

4. Government is pleased to direct that all departments and offices in which members of class IV service are promoted to clerical posts in pursuance of these orders should report to the General Administration Department, the number of such promotions made during a year by the 15th January of the next year in the appended proforma. The first such report should be sent to this department for the year 1975 by the 31st January 1976.
