READ:- Government Resolution, General Administration Department No. RTR-1174-2032-XII, dated the 23rd September 1975. A

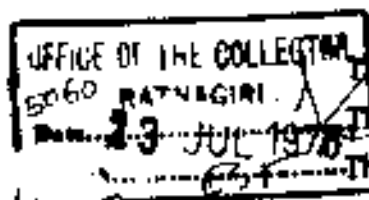
RESOLUTION:- Government is pleased to direct that the existing sub-para(2) of paragraph 2 of Government Resolution, General Administration Department No. RTR-1174-2032-XII, dated the 23rd September 1975 should be replaced by the following :-

"(2) The number of vacancies in the clerical cadre to be filled in by the promotion of Class IV persons falling in both the categories viz. (i) those, who had already passed the Secondary School Certificate Examination at the time of their appointment to Class -IV and (ii) those, who pass that examination after their appointment to Class-IV, should not exceed 25% of the vacancies occurring in a particular year".
